What is Strabismus?

- A condition in which the eye either has an inward or outward turn, or the eyes are not aligned.
- Strabismus usually appears in infants and young children, and most often by the time a child is 3 years of age.

1 in 20 Children have strabismus

Possible Symptoms

- An eye that wanders inwards or outwards
- Eyes that appear not to work together

- Poor depth perception
- **Blurred vision**
- **Double vision**
- Squinting
